

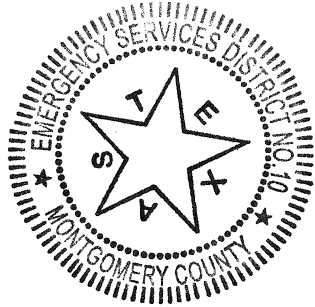
NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING
MONTGOMERY COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT No. 10

Notice is hereby given that the Board of Commissioners of the **MONTGOMERY COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 10** will hold a meeting on **November 18, 2021 at 3:30 p.m.** at the following location in the District: **Magnolia Volunteer Fire Department, Station 181, 18215 Buddy Riley Blvd., Magnolia, Texas, 77354.**

The District will consider and act upon the following matters:

1. Call meeting to order.
2. Roll Call, Pledge of Allegiance, Pledge of Texas and Invocation.
3. To receive public comment.
4. To pay District bills.
5. To review and take action on public outreach and communications, including reports from consultants and District Committees on same.
6. To review and take action on issues related to the District assuming direct provision of emergency services, including actions to employ staff, and transfer of assets from the Magnolia Volunteer Fire Department (the "Department") to the District.
7. To review and take action on the acquisition of capital assets, including fire fighting equipment, vehicles and apparatus and the acquisition financing of same.
8. To meet in Closed Session pursuant to Government Code §551.071 to consult with legal counsel regarding pending or contemplated litigation, settlement offers or on matters which require confidentiality under the Texas Disciplinary Rules of Professional Conduct of the State Bar of Texas and Tax Code §323.3022 to discuss sales tax matters.
9. To meet in Closed Session pursuant to Government Code §551.072 to deliberate regarding real estate matters.
10. To meet in Closed Session pursuant to Government Code §551.074 to deliberate the appointment, employment, evaluation, reassignment, duties, discipline, or dismissal of a public officer or employee; or to hear a complaint or a charge against an officer or employee, including the District administrative staff, executive staff and Fire Chief. Any employee the subject of review will be given the opportunity to request open meeting discussion of the matters if they are present at the meeting.
11. To review and act on employment/personnel issues, including policies, handbooks, procedures, hiring, retention, compensation, benefits, scheduling, complaints and discipline of District employees, including administrative staff, executive staff and Fire Chief.
12. To review and act on real estate matters, including but not limited to purchase, sale, lease, utilities, encumbrances, easements and filings.
13. To review and action on repairs or renovations to District or Department facilities.
14. To review and take action on scheduling District meetings.
